OBJECTIVE:


A state level webinar on **Intellectual Property Right- Geographical Indications** was conducted by IPR Cell and Research and PG Department of Commerce on 28.04.2022 at 10 am through Google Meet platform. The session was handled by Mr. Vipulkumar N. M. Assistant Professor, KristuJayanthi College (Autonomous) Bengaluru. A briefing on the session is given below.

Intellectual property is a category of property that includes intangible creations of the human intellect, and primarily encompasses copyrights, patents, and trademarks. It also includes other types of rights, such as trade secrets, publicity rights, moral rights, and rights against unfair competition. Artistic works like music and literature, as well as some discoveries, inventions, words, phrases, symbols, and designs can all be protected as intellectual property.

The following topics were covered in the session.

- Intellectual Property Rights (IPRs) – An Introduction with need of its protection
- Copyright and Trademark Management in India with case studies
- Ethical Issues related to Clinical Trials and IPR
- Compulsory licensing and Bolar Exemption in India
- Patenting of pharmaceutical compositions and medical devices – Guidelines
- Procedure of Patent filing, Commercialization of patents
- Patent System in India and National Biodiversity - Biotechnological inventions
- Tools for Patent Searching - Panel Discussion on Life Science Inventions

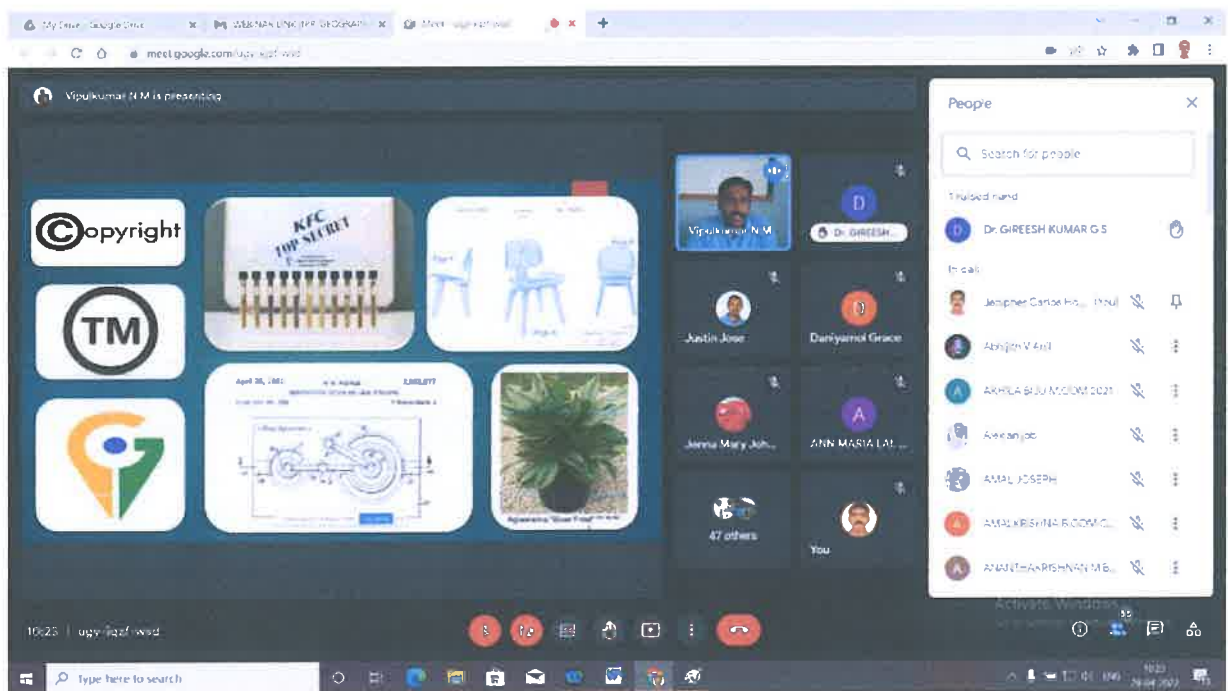


