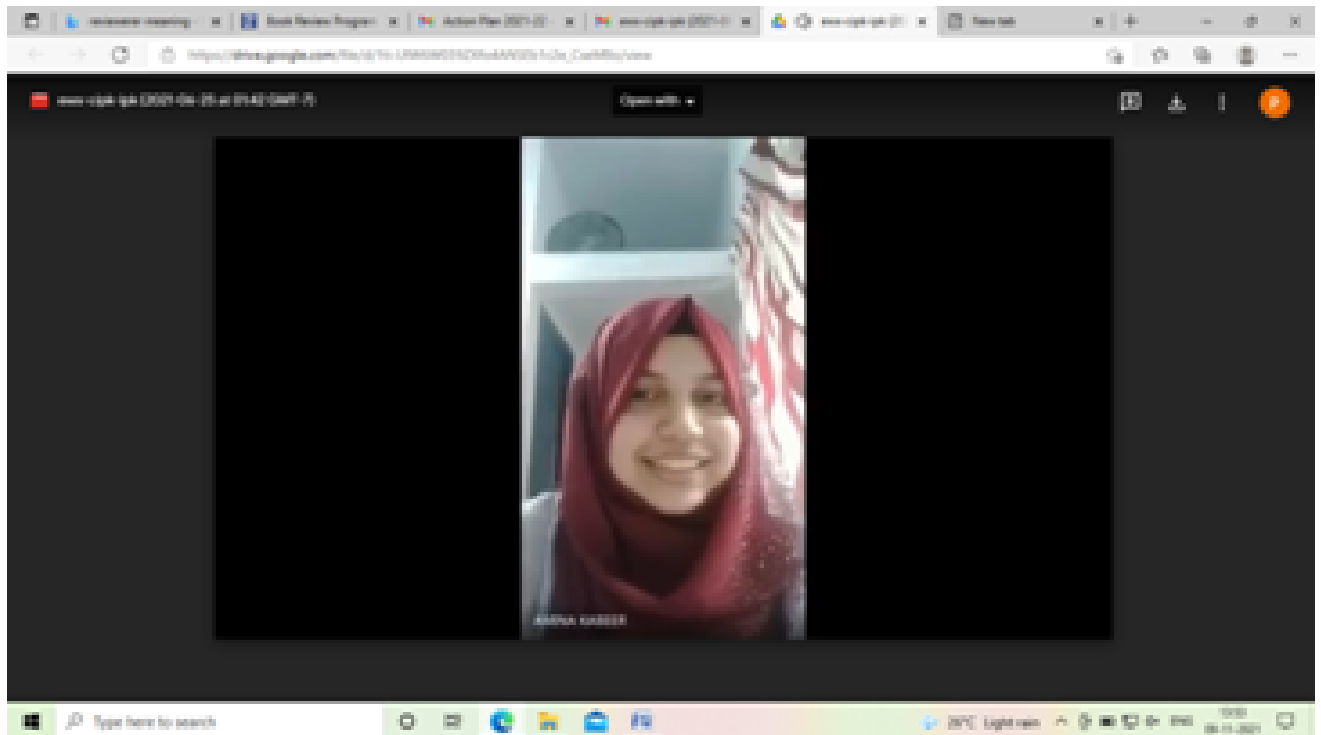
## Book Talk

The major objectives of the programme were to improve the quality of reading habit of the students and to enhance their presentation skills. On the first day of the programme, coordinator Paul Mathews welcomed the virtual gathering and Principal Dr. Gireeshkumar G. S. inaugurated the programme. He wholeheartedly felicitated the initiative and congratulated all the student reviewers. Total fifty-three students and six teachers attended the programme.

Following the formal inauguration on the first day, Ms. Amina Kabeer of III B. A. English presented a review of the novel A Lonely Harvest by Perumal Murugan.
