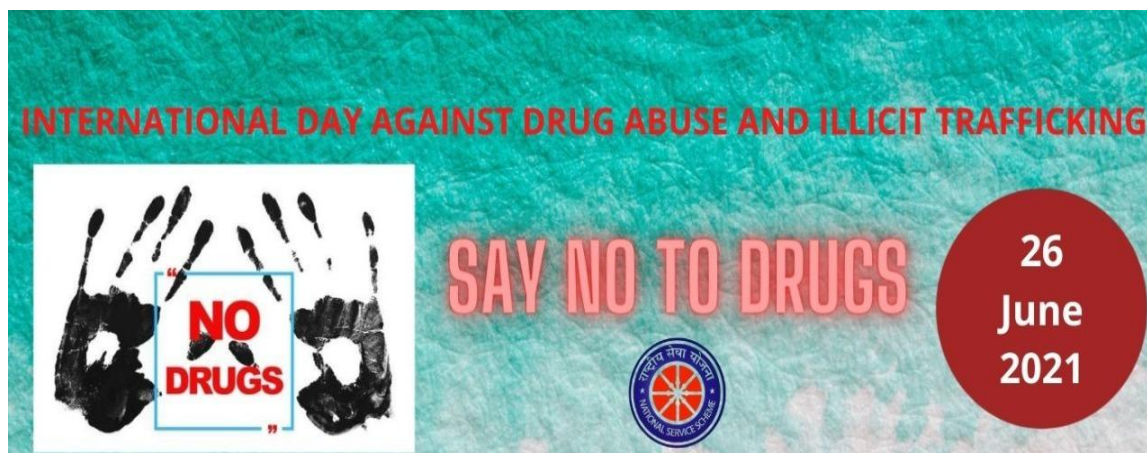
2. Programme: International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking

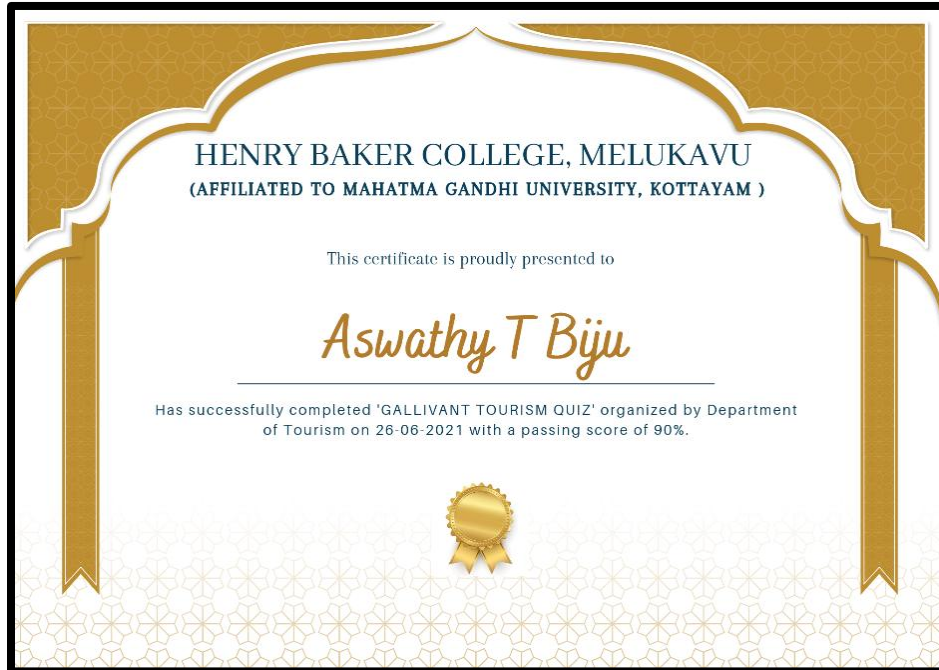

4. Programme: Webinar on Anti Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking

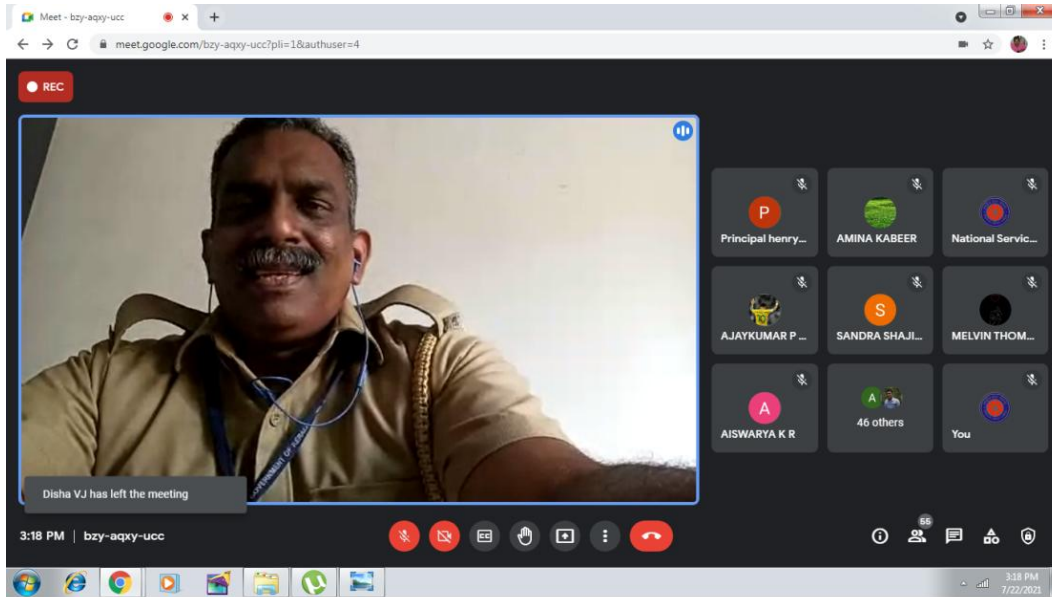
Date: 22-07-2021

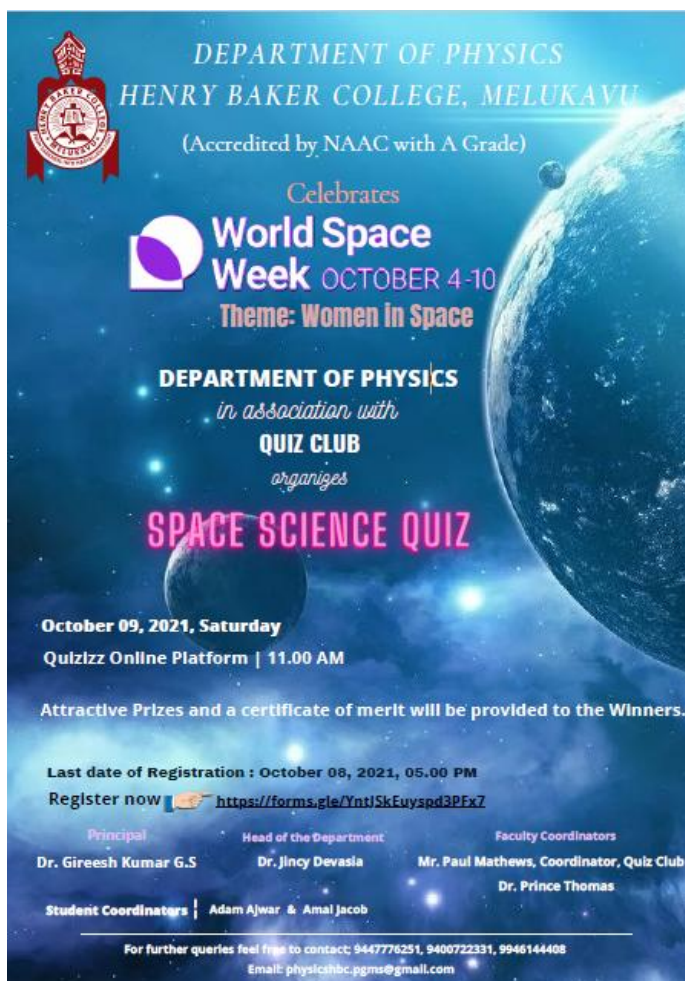
Intra-collegiate Quiz Competition

Objective: Create awareness on Cyber crimes and Cyber laws which is related to legal informatics, e-commerce, software and information security.

National Service Scheme of Henry Baker College, in association with Meenachil Thaluk Legal Service Committee and Lions Club of Aruvithura organized a webinar on Cyber Law on 18 October 2021. 9. Programme: Flood Relief Activities

Date: 12-11-2021

Organized by: NSS Unit, Henry Baker College

The low pressure developed in the East-central Arabian Sea on October 14, 2021 triggered heavy rainfall in Kerala and the rain, in turn, led to flash floods and landslides. Many landslides occurred in Kottayam and Idukki districts. Around fifty people lost their lives and many of them found missing. Thirteen individuals died in landslides at Kootickal, Kottayam. Our NSS unit took active efforts to raise money for the Kootickal relief activities. As a result, a sum of Rs. 32000/- was collected from the students and teachers of Henry Baker College, Melukavu. The programme officers and volunteers contacted the Kootickal Panchayat Office and discussed about the needs of the time. They got an opportunity to interact with the victims and listen to their problems. The financial aid was handed over by the volunteer secretaries to the two families ((Rs.15000/- per family) in Kootickal for making toilet facilities on 12.11.2021. The NSS identified a student of our college, who is a resident of Kootickal and extended helping hands to her by paying her hostel fees of Rs. 2000/- on 11.11.2021. The HBC NSS extends our gratitude to the Principal Dr. Gireesh Kumar G. S, staff and students for their kind contributions.

Objectives:

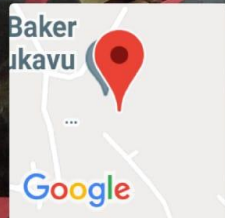
1. To sensitize the students the need of donating blood to the needy in emergency situations

12. Programme: Drainage Construction

Date: 27-12-2022

Organized by: NSS Unit, Henry Baker College

On 27.12.2022, NSS volunteers constructed a drainage in Ward No 12 of Melukavu Gramapanchayath. One of the houses situated very close to the Melukavumattom - Pala main road faced a major problem during the last two monsoon seasons. Their garden and vegetable cultivations were at the risk of devastation from the large quantity of rain water flowing from the road in front of their house to their compound. Having no specific pathway to flow and drain these run off water , the land was easily prone to soil erosion and land slide too. Panchayath President Sri. T. J. Benjamin and Ward Member Ms Dency Biju approached the NSS Unit to resolve the issue. After proper planning, our volunteers decided to take up the challenge and assured support to the family. Our volunteers made a pathway for the proper flow of the run off rain water to the nearby river. Such a long time issue was thus addressed successfully and it was a very proud intervention by the NSS unit of our college. This service helped them to identify the needs and problems of the community and involve them in problem solving process.



13. Programme: Filaria Elimination Survey

Date: 04-03-2022 and 05-03-2022

Organized by: NSS Unit, Henry Baker College in association with Community Health Centre, Edamaruku

On the 4th and 5th of March 2022, a Two Day Filaria Elimination Survey was conducted under the initiation of Community Health Centre, Edamaruku and the NSS volunteers of Henry Baker College Melukavumattom. The programme started with a brief awareness class by the Medical officer of Community Health Centre, Edamaruku. After the class, the volunteers split up into many groups and visited different areas of Melukavu Panchayath. Each group was accompanied by health workers. Volunteers made a survey and insisted the local communities to empty the vessels that could be a breeding place for thousands of infective mosquitoes. Importance of personal hygiene and safe disposal of all types of household wastes were stressed by the volunteers. They encouraged the children in the families to have an extra eye on matters like these and gave them charge of clearing water holding vessels, wastes etc. The Filaria Elimination programme and survey was a new experience to our NSS volunteers and also to the local community.
