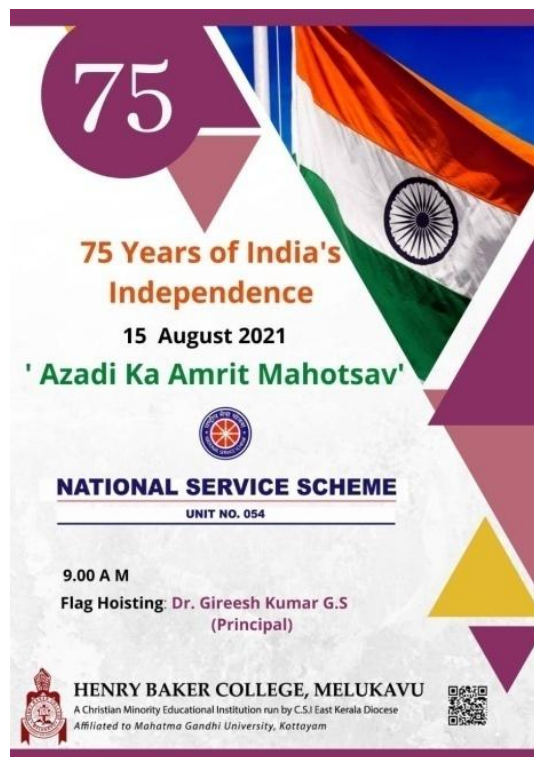
## 1. Programme: Independence Day Celebrations

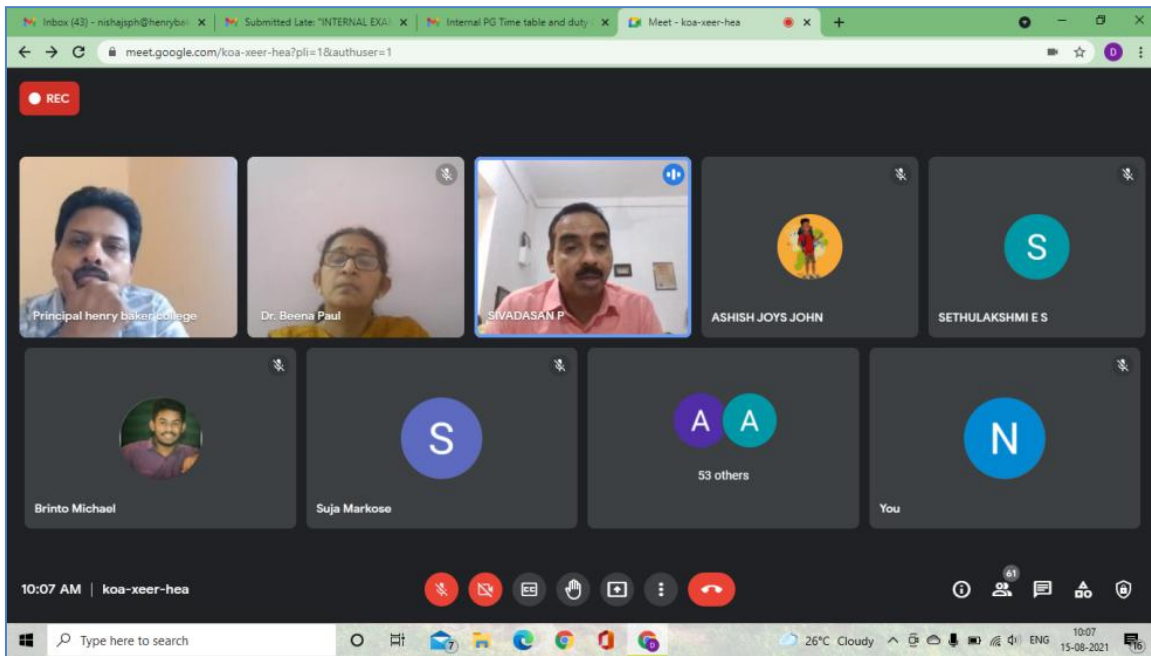
### **Outcome**

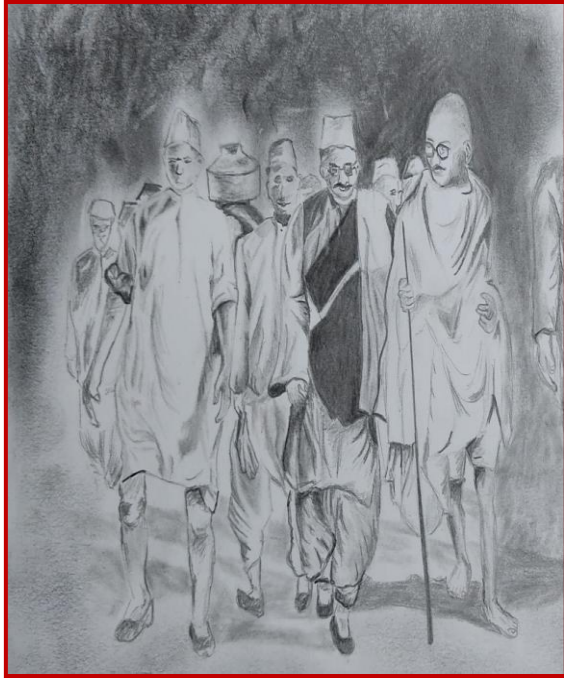

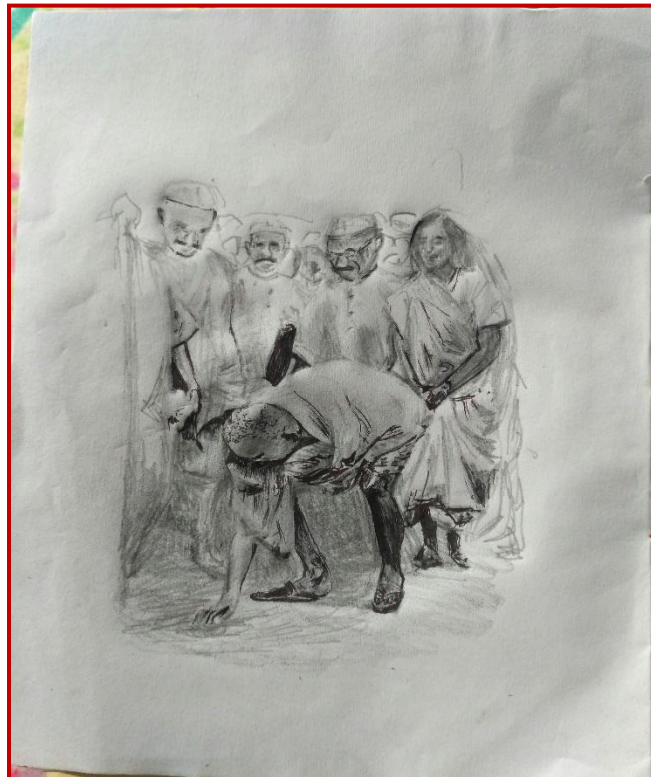
**Organized by: Women's Cell, Henry Baker College**

**Organized by: Dept. of History, Henry Baker College**

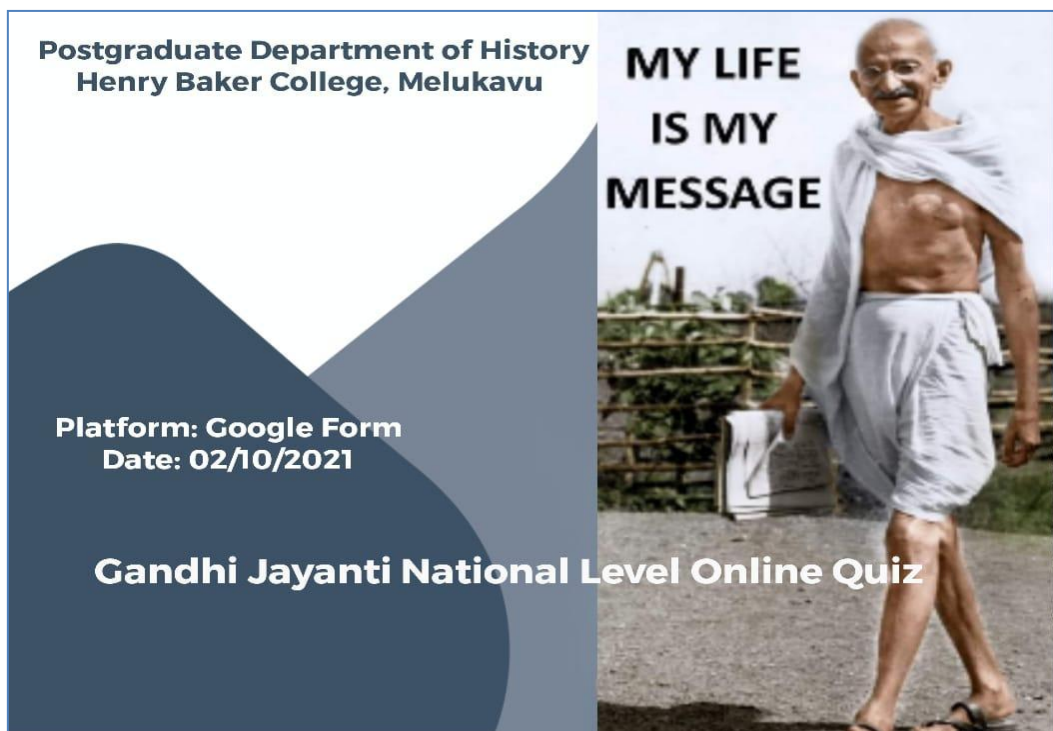
### ***Objective :***

The objective of the national level quiz conducted on the Gandhi Jayanthi day of 2021 was to give the students an insight into different phases of Gandhian Life.

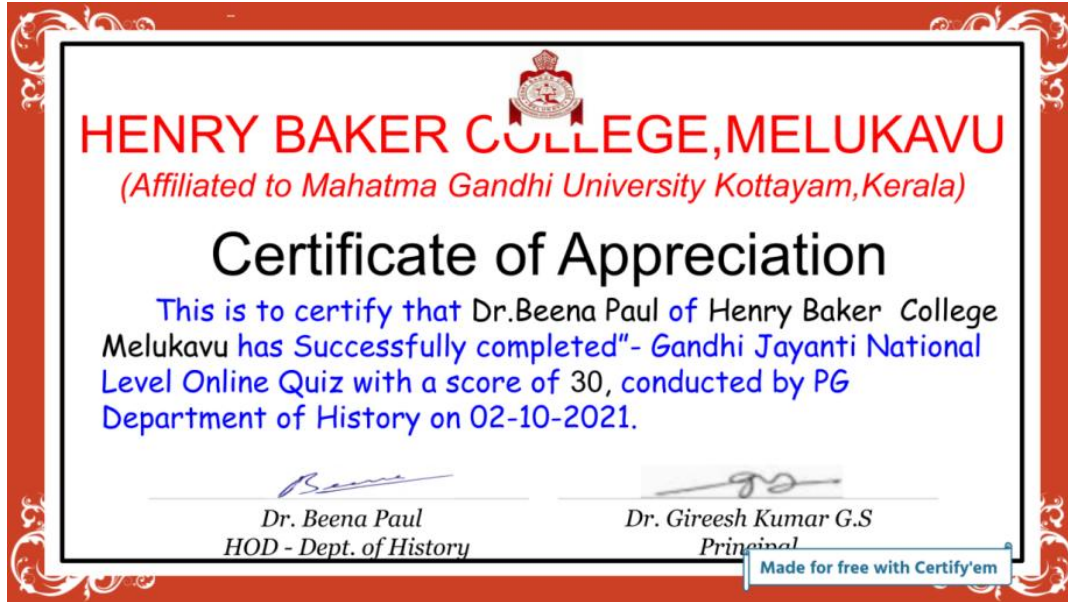

### **a. The Rastriya Ektha Diwas Pledge Taking**

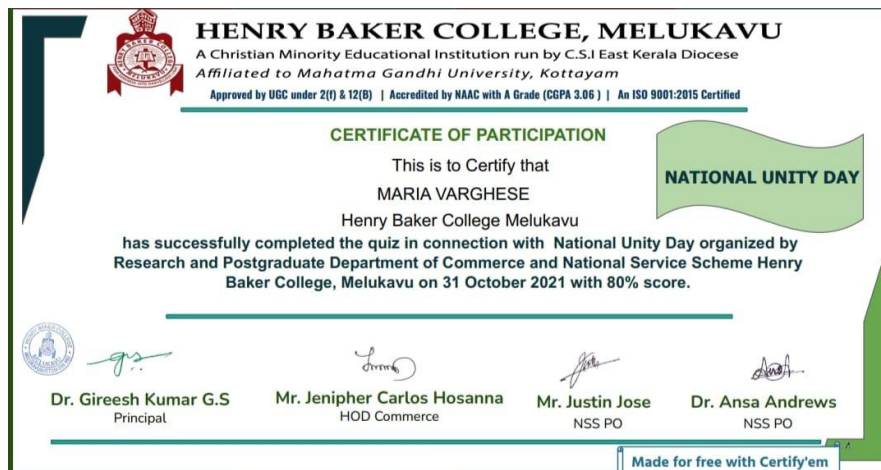
The NSS volunteers of Henry Baker College, Melukavu took pledge and dedicated themselves to preserve the unity, integrity and security of the nation.

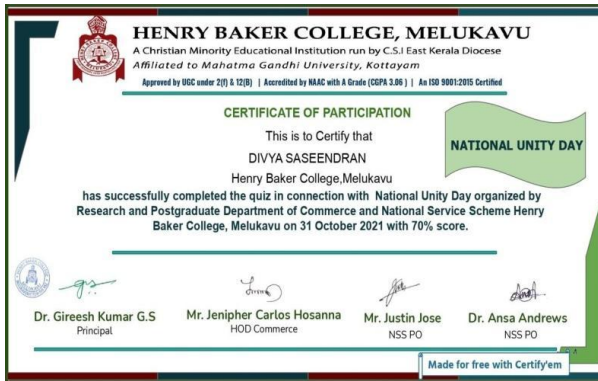




### b. Online Quiz

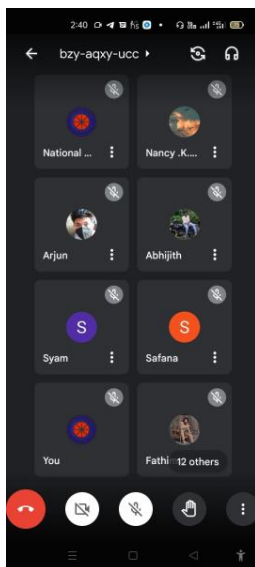
The NSS unit of Henry Baker College, Melukavu organised an online quiz programme on National Unity Day. Sixty students participated in the programme.


## 9. Programme: National Unity Day Quiz Competition
