Dr. Jibin Mathew, Assistant Professor of History, gave the welcome speech and introduced Dr. Sebastian Joseph, a noted film and environmental historian. The presidential address was given by Dr. Nisha Joseph, Assistant Professor of History.

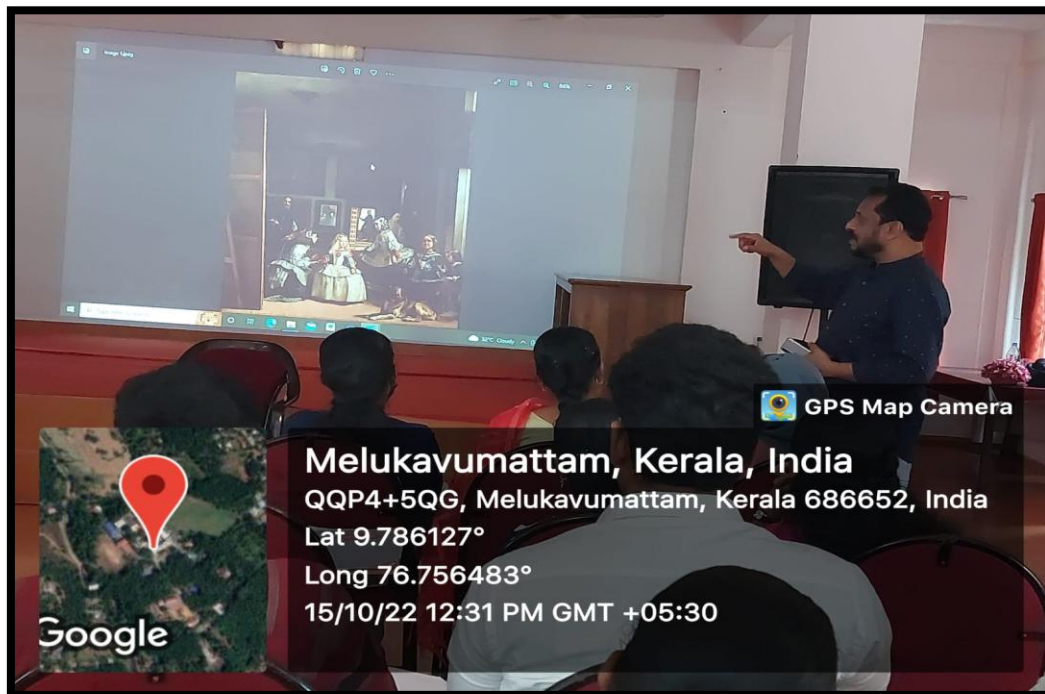

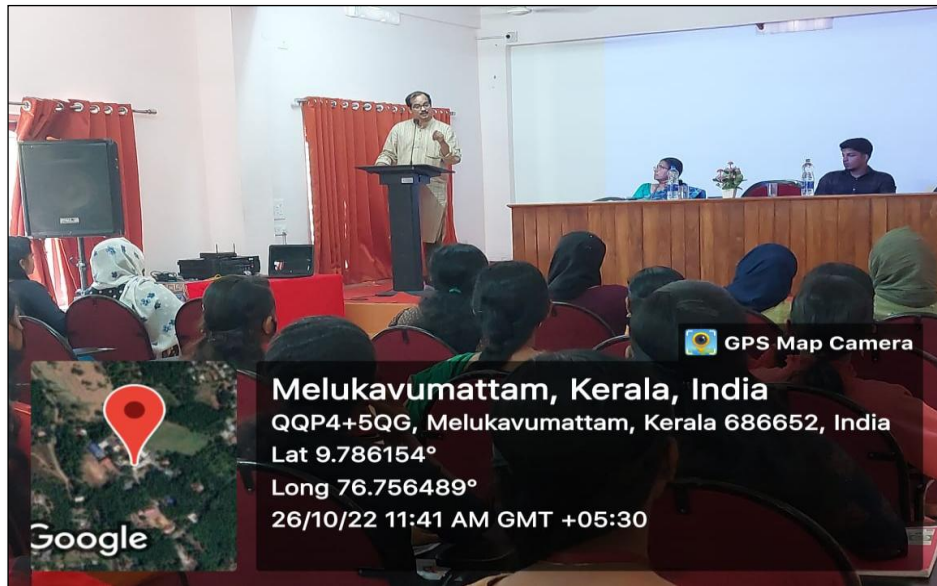

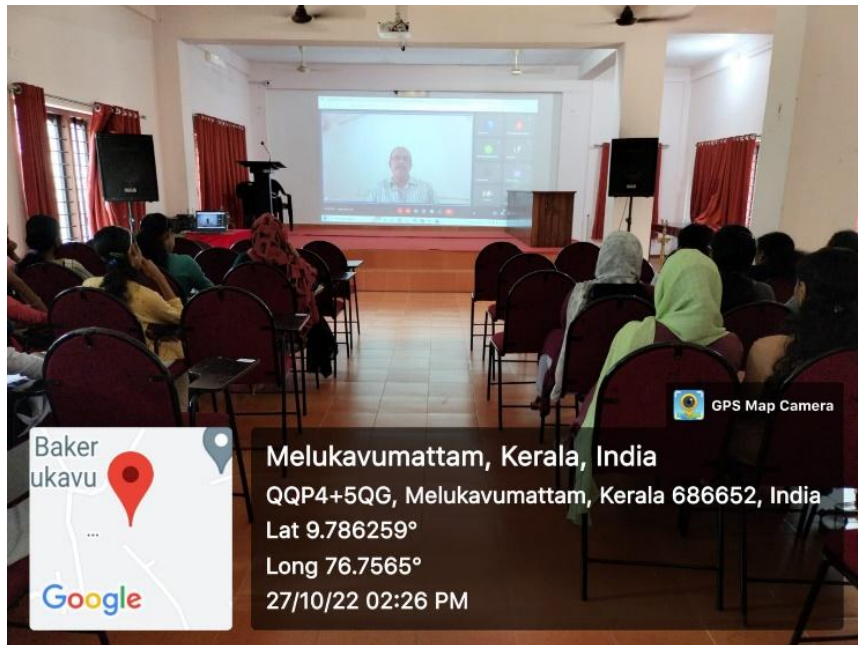


4. Impactful Approach for Plagiarism Free Research 27/ 10/ 2022

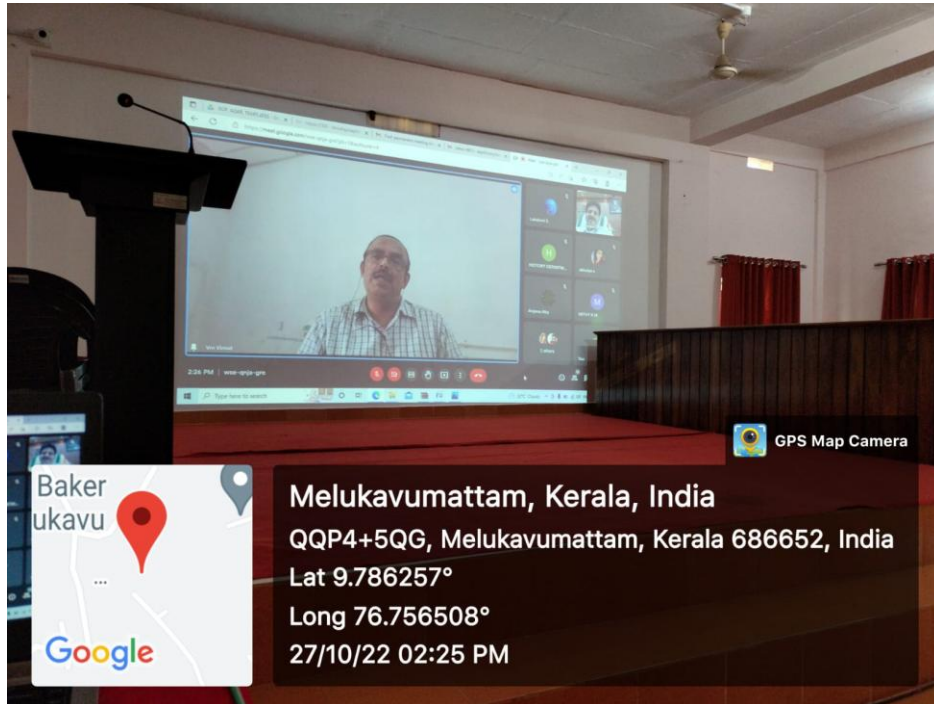
