## 1. Workshop on ‘Research in History: Methods and Practices’

### Objective:

The workshop aimed to provide an in-depth understanding of historical research methodologies and best practices, catering to history students.

### Report:

On 16<sup>th</sup> September 2023, a workshop on "Research in History: Methods and Practices" was held at the PG Department of History, Henry Baker College. The workshop was intended for UG students. The resource person, Santhosh George, Assistant Professor in History, Pavanatma College, Murikkassery provided an overview of historical research methods and also helped the students to identify research problem to develop research questions, to prepare literature review, and instructions on the collection historical sources as well as the impartial handling of source materials. He highlighted the differences between qualitative and quantitative approaches and discussed the strengths and limitations of each. The workshop had many interactive activities. Participants were divided into groups and asked to identify a research topic, develop a research question, to identify and analyze sources, and present their findings.

### Outcome:

These activities fostered collaboration and provided practical experience in historical research and had the advantage of getting a frame work for their UG History Project.

### 3. Craft Demonstration Programme

Mr. Lenin Raj K R shed light on the initiatives undertaken by the Ministry of Textiles in implementing various marketing, design, and welfare schemes for handicraft artisans. Dr. Gireesh Kumar, Principal of Henry Baker College, delivered the keynote address, emphasizing the significance of skill development programmes for students, aligning with the goals of the National Education Policy. Manoj M V, Coordinator of Kudayathoor Development Society, shared his insights. Dr. Sneha Susan Mathew, Coordinator of the Institution Innovation Council, felicitated the occasion.

### Demonstration Sessions:

After the inauguration, artisans conducted training sessions on various craft forms for students. These included:

1. Coconut Shell Handicrafts: Students were taught the art of crafting intricate designs using coconut shells.
2. Bangles and Chain Making: Artisans demonstrated the process of making traditional bangles and chains, showcasing the rich heritage of Kerala's craftsmanship.
3. 'Nettipattom' Crafting: Students learned the techniques involved in making 'Nettipattom', ornamental headdresses worn by elephants during festivals and often used as decorative pieces in households.

The program continued for the next two days, providing students from various departments with training in craft demonstrations. Participants expressed great enthusiasm and satisfaction in learning these traditional crafts. In two days workshop 111 students and 10 teachers participated in the program.

The Three-Day Craft Demonstration Program gave students an immersive experience in Kerala's rich handicraft traditions. Through interactive sessions and hands-on demonstrations, participants gained valuable insights into various craft forms, deepening their appreciation for

the state's cultural heritage. These initiatives are crucial in preserving and promoting indigenous crafts while empowering artisans and nurturing the next generation of skilled craftsmen and craftswomen.





### **Objective:**

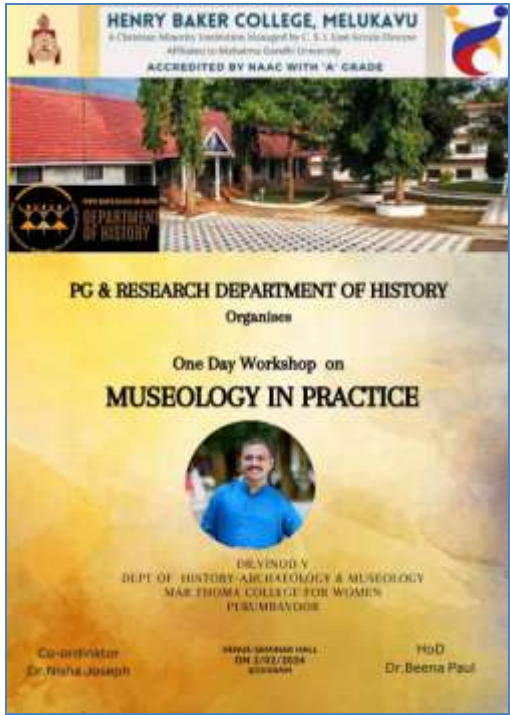
To provide participants with practical skills and knowledge essential for effective museum management and exhibition design.
