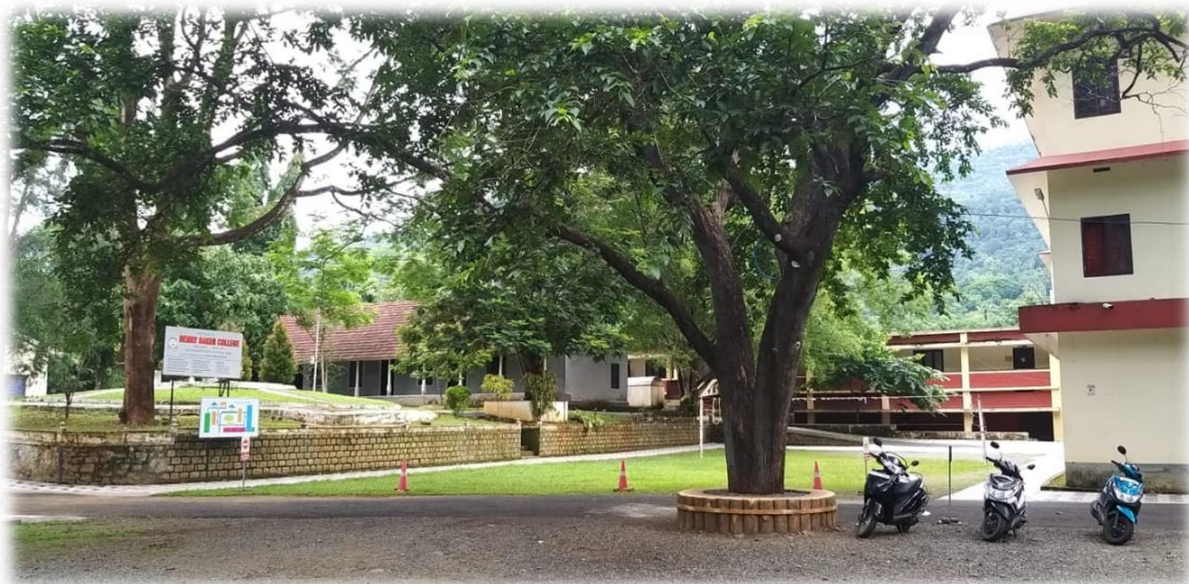

Kurup, former Vice-Chancellor, University of Calicut inaugurated the seminar and talked on **“Impact of Land Reforms on Kerala Society”**. In the afternoon session, Dr. K. S. Pradeepkumar, Deputy Director (Training) KIRTADS, Kozhikode talked on **Trajectories of tribal development** and Prof. T. M. Yesudasan, Asso. Prof. (Rtd.) CMS College Kottayam talked on **Sixty Years of Life on the Margins** respectively. The seminar in the College auditorium ended at 4.00p.m with the vote of thanks of Dr. Nisha Joseph.

The purpose of the seminar was to have an overview of changing methodologies on researching Kerala History and Culture over the last sixty years. The focus of the seminar was on three key areas, viz., land, tribes and daliths. The seminar was intended to identify and analyze sixty years of challenges and prospects of the weak and marginalized sections in Kerala. Also changes in the land patterns and relationships and its impact thereof.

There were altogether 119 participants. Research scholars and staff from other institutions also attended the seminar.
