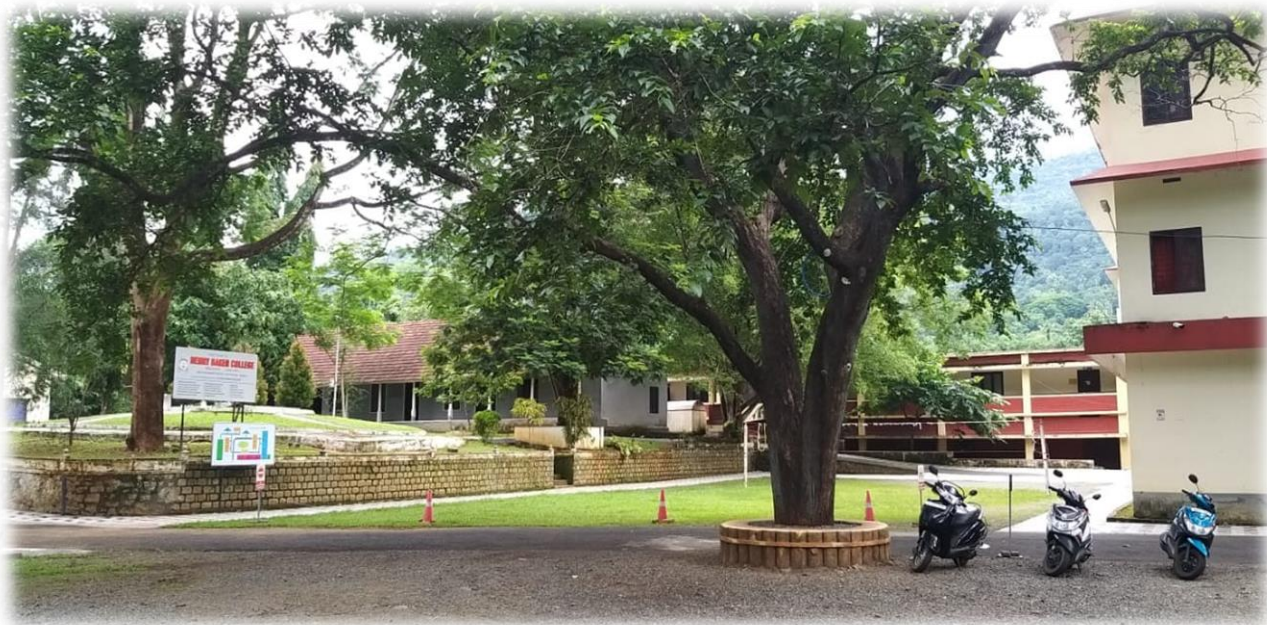

On 3rd February 2018, department of History organised a **Workshop on Oral History Archiving and Methodology**. The purpose of the seminar was to equip the students of the department to record and preserve the oral memories of the people in and around Melukavu. - To understand an organic resource base for studying and understanding the past.
- To introduce the need to recognize and acknowledge the unheard memories and voices that would otherwise remain invisible.
