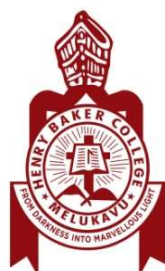
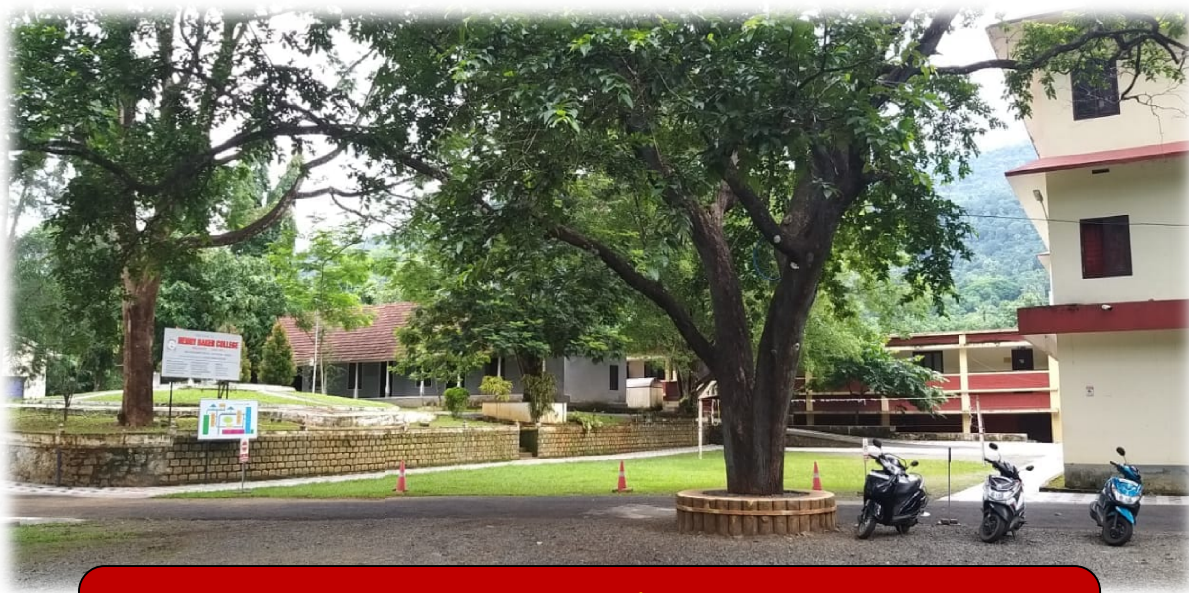

From the survey we also came to know that only a few among them is educated and majority of them are illiterate. And their ignorance is always misused by non-tribes. The team

offered the support of the college while interacting with them and assured them help in times of need.

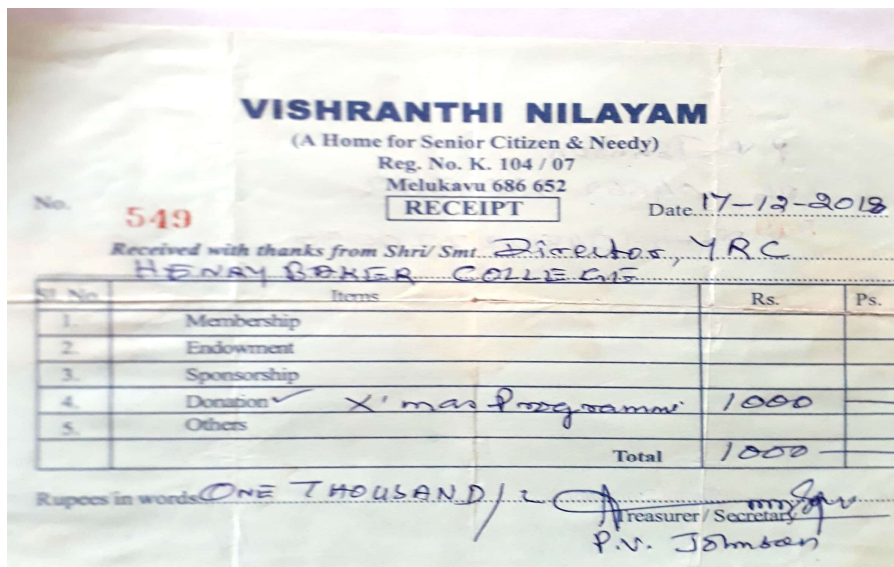

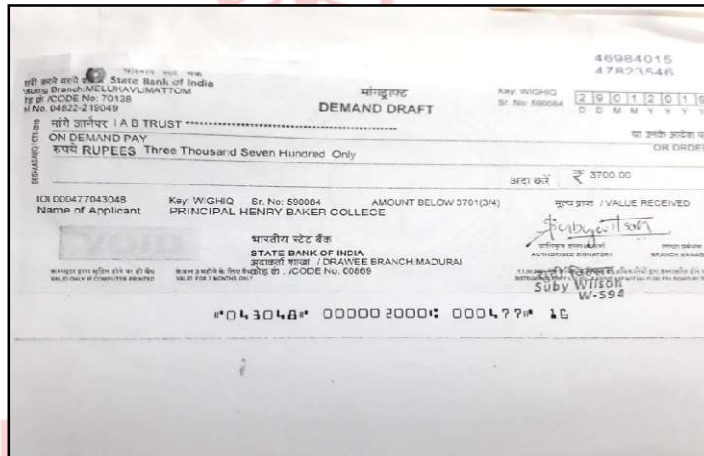
CLEANING FLOOD AFFECTED HOUSES AT CHERUTHONI BY NSS - "SUKRTHAM 2018"
