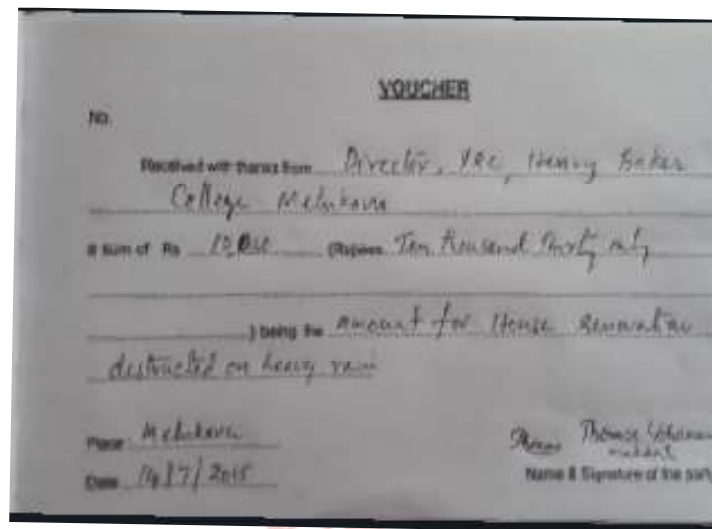
WORLD POPULATION DAY
