
• Topic: Efficient Utilization of Funds

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
• Topic: Efficient Use of Technology in Administration


• Topic: PD Account Management


• Topic: Guidance on E- Grants and Stipend


• Topic: Orientation programme on KSR

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
Topic:Guidance on Store Purchase Manual and Accounts

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
• Topic: Training on Cash Book Maintenance and Fund Utilization


• One day Training Programme on 'Pay Fixation and Increment'
