Due to Flood, there was no Onam Celebration in this Academic Year

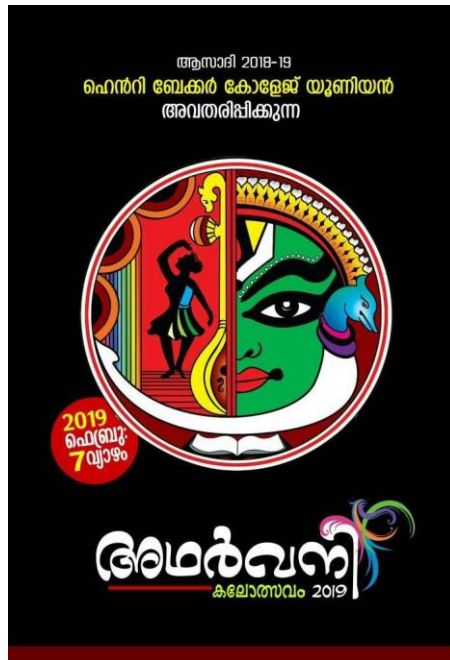
#### Kearalampiravi 2018
