During the academic year of 2019-2020, Department of Commerce Computer Application constitutes 6 faculty members and 84 students. Of these, 30 students have taken admission for the first year. Orientation classes and Bridge courses were conducted by Henry Baker College for the newly admitted students. The department evaluates the score of Bridge courses as one of the criteria for identifying advanced learners and slow learners.
