Henry Baker College Melukavu got sanctioned B.Voc: Tourism and Hospitality Management from UGC as per NSQF along with few other colleges under MG University, Kottayam. This course is the first B. Voc course in the college and sixth Undergraduate course affiliated to MG University, Kottayam. As a college situated in a rural and tribal area and major chunk of students belong to vulnerable sections such as SC, ST, OEC and OBC, the course is of vital significance in imparting skills to improve employability among youth in this region. College started the course with excitement and great expectations. College could successfully start and continue the course for last 3 months and diverse programs have been organized as a part of the course.

INAUGURATION

The course was inaugurated on **1 Nov 2018** and officially started classes. The College Principal Dr. Gireesh Kumar G.S inaugurated the three year degree course B.Voc: Tourism and Hospitality Management in the presence of students, parents, the Course Co-ordinator and the three newly appointed faculty members. The following faculty members were recruited for the Department of Tourism Studies:


1. Mr.Anish Thanikkal MTA

In total, 22 students joined the course consisting of 18 boys and 4 girls. Students were selected based on merit by following the set regulations of UGC/MG University. Most of the teachers have industry and /teaching experience with adequate academic qualifications to handle various subjects. According to the designed syllabus, we have started the classes from 2 Nov 2018 onwards.

According to the syllabus, each subject has **4 lecture hours per week** along with an **activity hour**, to ensure that the students have adequate knowledge and skills, so that they are ready to work at each exit point. The accomplished activities as a part of the program are as follows:

1. DESTINATION VISIT 1-ILLIKAL KALLU & KATTIKAYAM WATERFALLS

As Part of the curriculum, the department has set the first academic outdoor activity- A Destination Visit to Illickal Kallu and Kattikayam Waterfalls, on 17th Nov 2018. Based on the visit, the students had recorded a **Documentary** about the above mentioned tourist spots, being one of the less explored destinations in Kottayam district. The outdoor visit was a wonderful experience for the students.


Students got an excellent opportunity to know about the various department works in a travel agency.
