This noble endeavor involved mobilizing donations from students and faculty members to provide sustenance for patients at Kottayam Medical College and procuring clothing for differently-abled students at Santhinilayam for Handicapped Children in Kollappally. The initiative, dedicated in memory of Sri. Jenipher Carlos Hosanna, Assistant Professor in the Department of Commerce, who passed away on 14/11/2022, successfully collected a sum of Rs. 48,000. A significant portion of this fund, Rs. 24,000, was allocated to providing nourishment to cancer patients at Kottayam Medical College, while the remaining Rs. 24,000 was directed toward supporting the differently-abled students at Santhinilayam, Kollappally.

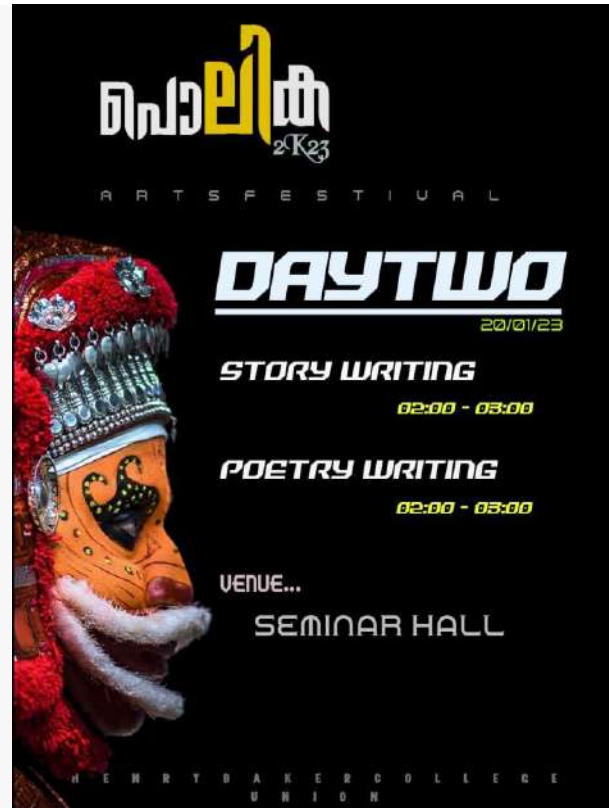
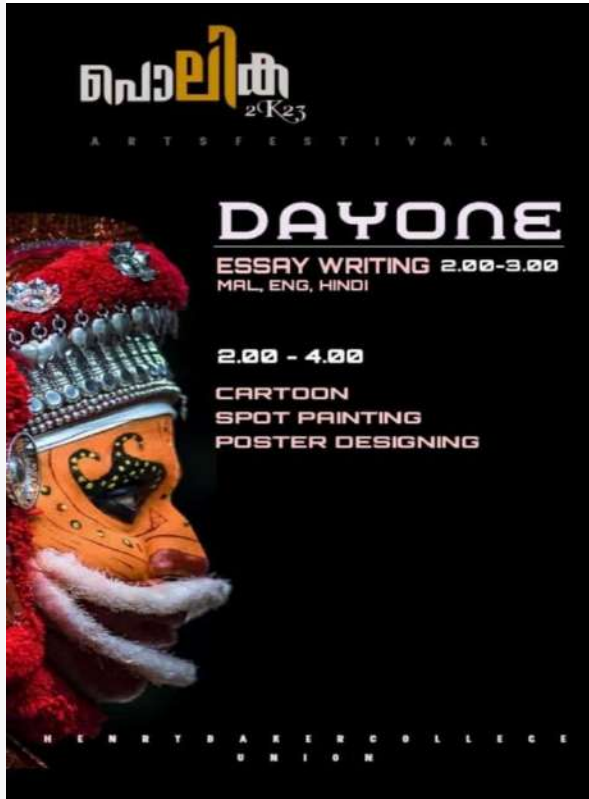
**Arts Fest- POLIKA 2023**

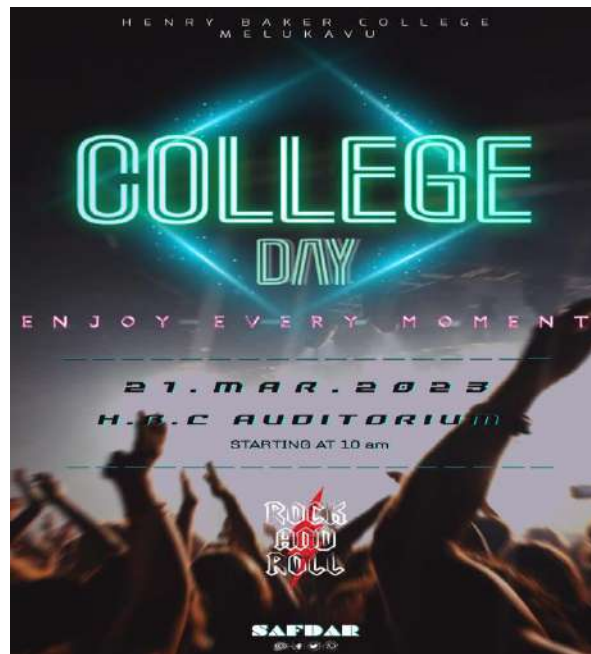
