Programs and activities conducted in the hostel:

- 1. **Spoken English Classes** : In the month of June, Ms. Tracey Walker has taken Spoken English Training sections in the hostel. The classes were concluded by 3rd July 2015.

- 6. **Onam Celebration**: Onam celebration was conducted in the hostel on 20 August 2015, with Pookalam and a variety of other entertainments, like Thiruvathira, Onappattu,and Pulikali. Traditional Sadya was served to the Hostel Administrators, students and staff of the hostel.
