## REPORT OF THE DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES 2016-2017

#### 1. World Environment Day

Department of History Commemorated World Environment Day on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2016. On the day department organised a talk on *Environmental Pollution* by Prof. Liza George, Head of the Department of Physics. The Talk was highly informative. Students were given awareness about the environmental pollution. Sixty students attended the programme.



#### 2. Bridge Course

Bridge course was arranged for the first year students from 27/7/16 to 1/8/16. The course was offered to make the students ready to face the intellectual challenges of university education. A common awareness class was arranged for all the students of the college. On the second day, the students were given Orientation by Sri. Bobby Kannanthanam. From the third day onwards students were given orientation from their concerned departments. Students were introduced to new programme and entry level examination was conducted. Moreover one to one counselling was also arranged so as to understand the students and their backgrounds.

#### 3. Commemoration of Hiroshima Nagazaki day and Quit India day.

On 8<sup>th</sup> August 2016, department had commemorated Hiroshima Nagazaki Day and Quit India Day. This was to instil patriotism and make the students aware of the need to have a peaceful world. A meeting was arranged at 1.10 pm in the Bishop Michael John Memorial Hall to pay tribute to great Indian patriots. After that students with placards calling for peace, rallied the campus and assembled in the Kirby Garden. Dr. Beena Paul delivered the message.

#### 4. Department Library.

Since the inception of the library in the department, books are provided to the students for advanced learning as well as to enhance their interest in history through historical fictions. Selected books are collected and distributed among the students, to provide a distinct idea of historical events.

#### 5. Invited Talk

Prof. P. G. Haridas, Rtd. HOD and Principal, S.S.V College, Perumbavoor delivered a talk to IMA and II MA students on *Re-reading Marxism* on 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2016. The lecture helped to acquaint with recent advances on Marxist writings. Twenty four students participated in the programme.



#### 6. Study Tour

Students of III BA History visited Edakkal caves (a pre- historic rock shelter in Wayanad) and Jain Bhasthi, on Ist December 2016. Students got the opportunity to see the oldest pre-historic cave in Kerala and engravings on the rock. It was really an experience to see a primary source for historical studies.




## 7. Alumni meeting.

Alumni meeting of the year 2016-17was held on 26<sup>th</sup> January. 19 old students attended the meeting.




#### 8. History Association Inauguration

Dr. Vinod Kumar Kallolikal, Associate Professor, Maharajas College, Ernakulam delivered the lecture on "Permanence and Change in Tribal Health Care Systems: A Historical Perspective". Information about the continuity and change in the tribal health care system was provided by the expert. The talk was very informative and useful. Eighty students attended the programme.

Chief Guest of the programme was Dr. P. J. Cherian, Archaeologist and Former Director of KCHR, Thiruvananthapuram. 
