1. History Association Inauguration

2. Commemoration of Quit India Day and Hiroshima Nagasaki Day

Staff and students of the department of history conducted a **Peace Rally** in the campus with lighted candles. The rally ended in front of the Principal's office, with a message by Dr. Beena Paul, HoD Postgraduate

Department of History. Students made a board with Sadako paper cranes and the banyan tree of the campus was decorated with Sadako cranes. The programme ended at 2.00pm.





3. Orientation for MA students

One day orientation programme for IMA students were arranged in the Seminar hall on 1st November 2017. Forenoon session was common for MA and M.Com students. In the afternoon session students were given an introduction to the programme and syllabus. Dr. Gireeshkumar G.S, Principal of the college, welcomed the students to the College. 4. Study Tour - MA History Students
