Report of the Mentoring and Counselling Cell during the Academic Year 2019-2020.

Effective mentoring is a complex and multidimensional process of guiding a person. Since it advances the students' academic and personal growth, our college takes keen interest in the activities of Mentoring and Counselling Cell. Considering the significance of mentoring in moulding the character of students, a mentors' handbook "Jyothirgamaya" was introduced during the academic year 2019-20, to record systematically the details regarding the mentees. At the beginning of the year, all Heads of the Departments prepared a Mentoring list by equally allotting students to various teachers of their departments.
