The Cell discussed in detail about the various necessities of the student community and decided to implement several welfare measures for the needy.

The following are the Activities of the Academic Year 2019-20.

- Scholarships: The Cell circulated the details of the scholarships and various schemes available for the SC/ ST Students and encouraged them to avail maximum scholarships.
- SSP/ WWS: The cell constantly monitored the active participation of the SC/ ST students in the Walk With the Scholar and Students Support Programme conducted by the college.
- NET Coaching: The cell inspired the students who have the caliber to appear NET/
 JRF examinations and encouraged them to attend the NET coaching classes provided
 by our college. During the Academic year, a student from the Scheduled Caste
 cleared NET.
- Career Guidance: The Cell persuaded the students of the reserved categories to attend
 the orientation programs conducted by the Career Guidance Cell to enhance the
 employability of SC/ST candidates by providing them vocational guidance and
 career information.
- Mentoring: The Cell recommended special mentoring to the needy students who belong to SC/ST in order to overcome their personal as well as academic problems.

- The Cell actively participated in the SC/ ST Welfare Extension activity of our college in the Kurathikudi Tribal Settlement. The College established a Library named "Kurathikudi Grameena Vayanasala, "in the Kurathikudi Muthuvan Tribal Settlement.
- The Cell visited the tribal settlement at Methotty, near Poochapra on 21st February 2010.

The second meeting of SC/ ST Cell was held on 11 February 2020 for analyzing the activities of the current year and discussed whether the welfare measures are implemented effectively.
