1. Awareness Programme on First Aid and Vector Born Diseases

An awareness programme on First Aid and Vector born disease control was conducted on 13-06-2018 at 1.30pm in the college auditorium. Dr. Sainuddin K.M., Medical officer and Sri. Sakeer.K.B, Health Inspector of CHC, Edamaruku took classes on First aid and Vector born diseases respectively. 150 students attended the programme.







2. Karuthal -Visit to MDCMS School Boarding & Supply of Dress and Other Provisions.

Youth Red Cross Unit of Henry Baker College visited MDCMS School to supply Study materials like books, pen, pencil, eraser, scale, box and blankets and soaps. The YRC members collected the materials from teachers and students. Dr. Beena Paul, Director of YRC and Dr. Jincy Devasia Co-director and the student representatives - Prasad Johnson, Jyothilakshmi Venu, Laksmi Binu, Beema, and Aksa visited the school.

The team provided 25 blankets, 60 books, 30 soaps, 65 pens, 5 pencils, 3 boxes, 3 erasers, and 3 scales to the students.



3. Auto fare to Physically Disable.

The YRC members on 7th September 2018, decided to give one way auto fare to a physically disabled student. As per the decision, from 12/9/18 onwards the one way auto fare of Rs.1000 was given to him. The second year Commerce students provided the amount.

4. A Rupee a Day Programme and Welcome to First Year Members

The inauguration of 'A Rupee a Day' Programme was held on 18-9-18 at 1.10 pm. The programme was to collect 1 Rupee per day from each student and to utilize it for charity purpose. Rev. Biju Joseph, Clergy secretary East Kerala Diocese and the College governing body member, inaugurated the programme. The meeting also welcomed the first year students to YRC. Rev. Biju talked about the role of youth in serving the society.




6. Visit to Visrandhi Nilayam
